Logistics Personnel Proponency manages two multifunctional, data focused, opportunities for post-command Regular Army Logistics captains to participate in Training With Industry (TWI) with FEDEX Express in Memphis, TN and Deloitte in Rosslyn, VA.

Those selected to participate in TWI are embedded with industry partners and exposed to leading industry best practices and procedures. This exposure and education is an on-the-job experience that cannot be gained or replicated through the traditional military education and assignment process.

This program is 36 months. 12 months spent embedded with the industry partner and upon completion 24 months serving in an approved utilization assignment. Individuals incur a 36 month Additional Service Obligation (ADSO) for participating in TWI, with the first 24 months serving the utilization assignment requirement concurrently. Regular Army Logistics Officers (90A) wishing to be considered for this opportunity must meet the prerequisites as stated in the MILPER published annually.
