The Chief of Staff, Army, Deployment Excellence Award (DEA) Program was instituted in 2000 to recognize Active Army, Army National Guard and Army Reserve units and Installations for outstanding accomplishments which meet or exceed Army deployment standards. The objectives are to enhance unit deployment skills and proficiency, share innovative deployment initiatives, and to capture deployment training trends. This prestigious award highlights units and installations that consistently demonstrate deployment excellence, contributing to the Army's overall readiness and ability to rapidly respond to global contingencies. The DEA program is comprised of four categories, One Active Duty, one National Guard, one Army Reserve and the Installation category.
