MEMORANDUM FOR Brigade Commanders, Reserve Officer Training Corps

SUBJECT: Introduction to Logistics Basic Officer Leader Course

1. As Commandant of the Army Sustainment University I would like to personally welcome you and your newly assessed cadet to the logistics branch. Our 16-week Logistics Basic Officer Leader Course combines the resources of the three functional logistics basic branches (Quartermaster, Ordnance, Transportation) to produce a multifunctional lieutenant capable of performing in any logistics platoon leader role at the tactical level.
2. During Logistics Basic Officer Leader Course your future logistics leader will complete a 4 mile run in 36 minutes, a timed 12 mile ruckmarch, qualify on basic rifle marksmanship and land navigation, receive at least one leadership grade and be challenged on multiple academic assessments. Your future logistics leader will leave our Logistics Basic Officer Leader Course ready to compete, sustain and win in a Brigade Combat Team.
3. There are several actions you can take to prepare your future logistics leader for success. You should emphasize your logistics leader to prepare for the Army Combat Fitness Test as well as be able to run four miles concurrently. Officers assessed from ROTC have historically had administrative shortfalls with regards to not having Common Access Cards prior to arrival, not having a government travel credit card to pay for lodging and meals, not having access to government email, and not being enrolled in TRICARE for medical benefits. You can help prepare your future logistics leader by covering these known gaps.
