SUBJECT: Welcome to Logistics Branch

1. As Commandant of the Army Sustainment University (ASU) I would like to personally welcome you to the Logistics branch. Our combined Logistics Basic Officer Leader Course (LOG BOLC) is a modern training experience which provides all Quartermaster, Transportation, and Ordnance assessed officers with a world-class education. The LOG BOLC cadre -logistics professionals from across the Army- have the distinct honor and responsibility to train and develop lieutenants as basic branch logistics officers, prepared to lead a platoon in support of Large-Scale Combat Operations (LSCO).
